

Addendum to Town of Forestville Amended
Highway Ordinance #1 - 1987

In action taken at the last town board meeting, which was duly posted and called at 7:30 P.M. June 17, 2002 the Town Board of Forestville passed a resolution stating that all roadways, in order to qualify for the town's jurisdiction must be paved with a one and one fourth inch ($1\frac{1}{4}$ ") bituminous layer, this to be placed over other required layers, as specified in Ordinance #1 - 1987

All roadways to be accepted by the Town of Forestville, shall be twenty feet (20') in width and have gravel shoulders two feet (2') on each side of the paved portion to accommodate traffic and provide safety.
