Ordinance # 2017-5
To Regulate stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Door County

The Town Board of the Town of Forestville, Door County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13 Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This Ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Forestville is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:


1. No Parking on the west side of Mill Road from the driveway of the Forestville County Dam Park, south to the town limits.

B. The town chairperson or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.


C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$ 15

This ordinance is effective on October 31, 2017.
